## Math:

This week: We will be learning different strategies for addition and revisit making combinations of ten.

The Common Core Standards we'll be addressing are: Operations and Algebraic Thinking
1.OA.5 - Relate counting to addition and subtraction (e.g., by counting on 2 to add 2 ).
1.OA.6 - Add within 20, demonstrating fluency for addition within 10. Use mental strategies such as counting on; making ten; creating equivalent but easier known sums.

## Addition Strategies:

Double Facts:

| $0+0=0$ | $2+2=4$ | $4+4=8$ | $6+6=12$ | $8+8=16$ |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| $1+1=2$ | $3+3=6$ | $5+5=10$ | $7+7=14$ | $9+9=18$ |
| Doubles plus one: |  |  |  |  |

You can use known facts to add unknown facts, with doubles.
For example: $6+7=13$ or $6+6=12+1=13$ Since you know that $6+6=12$, you can add one more because 7 is one bigger than, therefore, $12+1=13$.

## Making Tens:

We will learn how to use a fact of 10 to get a sum.
For example: $8+6=8+2+4=10+4$
